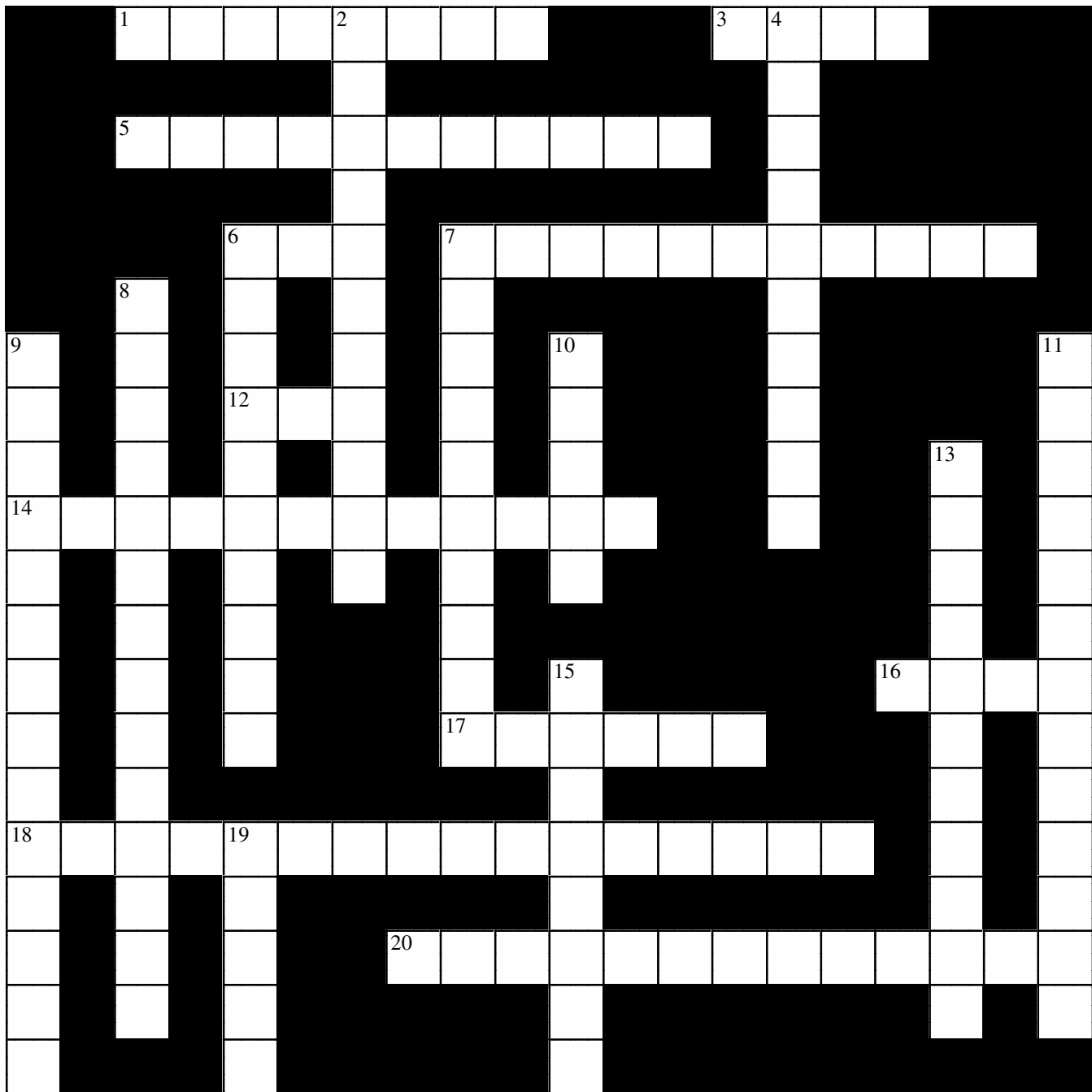


ABA BJ Puzzle of the Week: 8/5/10

ACROSS

1. Though frequently identified with Illinois, Abe Lincoln was actually born in this state.
3. Though he became President as a Republican, Lincoln's political career began with affiliation to this now-gone political party.
5. Monetary phrase that appears in teardrop-shaped devices on left and right of \$5 bill's face.
6. Polar opposite of "CSA," in terms of abbreviations used by the two armies fighting in Civil War.
7. Also known as MacArthur, Captain Hornblower, Nazi criminal Mengele, and "Penny" Baxter in "The Yearling," this actor played occupant of \$5 bill in TV movie "The Blue and the Gray."
12. Number of pictures of Lincoln on the most current \$5 bill?
14. Poet who wrote much-beloved biographical works about Lincoln. Some of his stories are now regarded as at least partially apocryphal.
16. Maiden name of Lincoln's wife.
17. If you look very closely towards the top of the building on the \$5 bill, you can see 26 of these. Indeed, Lincoln was no mere politician, but more a " _____ man."
18. An honorific used to describe Lincoln's work towards the freeing of the slaves, it marks an effort reflected nowhere on the \$5 bill.
20. Besides gracing the \$5 bill, Abe Lincoln's face appears on this S.D. monument with three other Presidents.

2. Much-travelled route during Lincoln's day, it lacked tracks, trains, and engineers, though it did have "stations."
4. Played book-loving young lawyer Lincoln in "Young Mr. Lincoln."
6. Contrary to popular myth, Lincoln, though much-remembered for this speech, wasn't the main speaker at commemoration for this battle.
7. The name "Lincoln" is a variety of the color which in turn became part of this name for U.S. currency around the time of Abe.
8. Which U.S. government entity mentioned on the \$5 bill did not exist when Lincoln was President?
9. Easily the largest (and longest) memorial to the \$5 bill occupant, this New York-San Francisco road was absorbed into U.S. Route 30, though elements remain.
10. What facial feature, included in the portraits on the \$5 bill, is missing from early photographs of Lincoln?
11. Long known for playing villains, this actor made such a name for himself playing Lincoln that one talk show host remarked that the actor wouldn't be happy until someone shot him.
13. Though better known for his many portrayals of Sam Clemens, this actor made his mark playing Lincoln a twain of times--in "North and South" and "North and South: Part II."
15. Type of bank created during Lincoln's administration.
