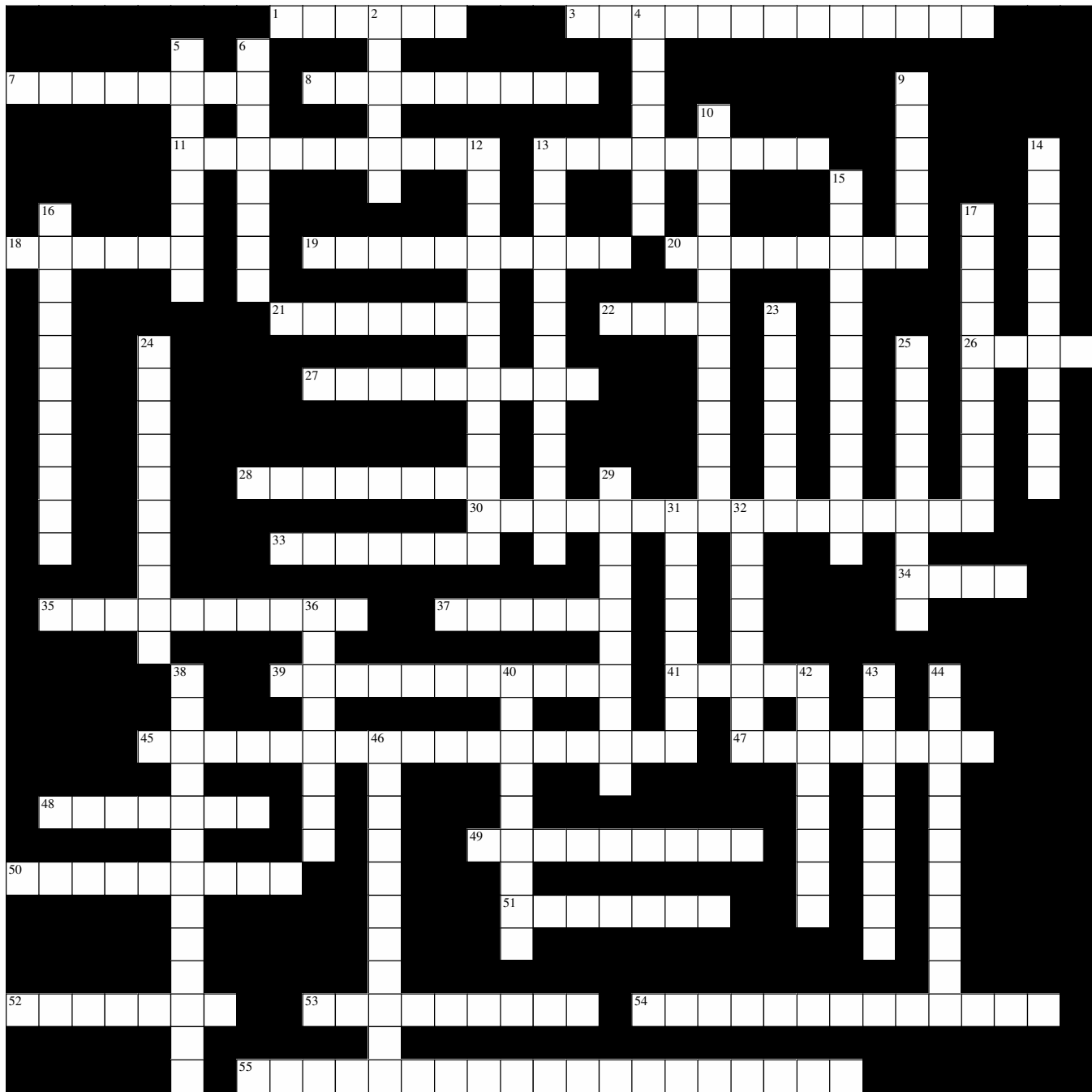


ABA BJ Puzzle of the Week: 7/15/10

The Washington Quarter is a veritable art gallery. Following up on recent years' state commemorative series, the U.S. Mint will be issuing "America the Beautiful" quarters, starting in 2010. In all, the series will honor 56 national parks and other sites in each state, the District of Columbia, and U.S. territories. The series will continue into 2021. Puzzle answers are mostly the names of each park or site, or the states where they are located. Abbreviations used in clues include: N.P. (national park); N.F. (national forest); N.M.P. (national military park); N.R.A. (national recreation area); N.H.P. (national historical park); N.M. (national monument) and N.H.S. (national historic site).

33. Aboriginally named state will have George Rogers Clark N.H.P. on its quarter.
34. Effigy Mounds National Monument can be explored in this state known as home to The Music Man's fictional River City.
35. Home to El Yunque N.F., this state's name translates to "rich port."
37. Lobster meets Tabasco! While Maine is far from Louisiana, name of this N.P. has roots of the word "cajun" in it.
39. Cubic landmass off R.I. coast is home to N.W.R. that will be on a 2018 quarter.
41. Frank Church-River of No Return Wilderness will be on this chimney-shaped state's 2019 quarter.
45. N.H.S. devoted to this author of Up From Slavery can be found in Washington, D.C.
47. Bombay Hook National Wildlife Refuge graces this state known for corporate headquarters and a Chancery Court that makes decision pivotal to corporate governance.
48. Montana N.P. makes for slow moving scenery that leaves some cold.
49. Voyageurs N.P. will represent this state of vikings, Prairie Home Companion, and one of 12 Federal Reserve District Banks.
50. Colorful federal parkway would have suited William Least Heat Moon, author of Blue Highways, if he had to pass through North Carolina.
51. Saratoga NHP can be found in this Empire State.
52. March-Billings-Rockefeller N.H.P. is the only unit of the U.S. National Park System in this "Green Mountain" state, other than its piece of the Appalachian Trail.
53. N.M.P. in Mississippi is also name of key, early Justice Department fair-lending case.
54. In 2020 this territory's "National Park of American Samoa" will be featured on a quarter. (This is a giveaway, folks.)
